1. BACKGROUND

SFF is a wholly owned subsidiary of CEF established by the Government and came into operation in 1977. The entity is mandated by the Minister of Energy to manage and control the Strategic stocks, Strategic assets and commercialization of the assets in order to fund the government mandate.

In 2012 SFF merged with Oil Pollution Control South Africa (OPCSA), which was previously a service provider to SFF. SFF manages three terminals: Saldanha, Milnerton and Ogies. Saldanha is fully utilized for both strategic crude storage and commercial activity with its revenue used to fund the mandate of SFF.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

Risk assessment:

The Ergonomic Regulations were promulgated on 06 December 2019. On 19 June 2020, a temporary exemption from Regulations 6 and 8 was granted by the Department of Employment and Labour. Essentially the temporary exemption delayed the requirement for an employer to perform an ergonomics risk assessment (Regulation 6) and to place an employee under medical surveillance (Regulation 8) until the end of June 2021.

The above temporary exemption comes to an end on 30 June 2021.

As such, employers will need to comply with Regulations 6 and 8 of the Ergonomic Regulations from 01 July 2021.

An employer must, before the commencement of any work that may expose employees to ergonomic risks, have an ergonomic risk assessment performed by a competent person.

The ergonomic risk assessment must include:

- (i) A complete ergonomic hazard identification following activities observed/advised at our site;
- (ii) The identification of all persons who may be affected by the ergonomic risks that flow from these identified hazards;
- (iii) An explanation of how employees may be affected by the ergonomic hazards;
- (iv) An analysis and evaluation of the ergonomic risks; and
- (v) The prioritisation of ergonomic risks.
